Dear praying friends,

The addition of Logan into our family has been a wonderful change. He has been growing and becoming more active, staying awake for several hours a day now. He is a calm yet noisy baby, already quite different in personality than Nathan. We praise the Lord for him daily.

I had a wonderful opportunity recently to make a hospital visit to a church member's mother who was close to death. She was unsaved and had pushed off becoming a Christian until the time that she believed she was "ready". As soon as I came into the hospital room where the family surrounded her, I was told that she was ready and eager to trust Christ. Within a few minutes, she did just that. How wonderful to see the relief on her daughter's face when she settled her eternity. She is now enjoying the beauty of Heaven in the presence of our Savior.

As the day that we depart for the field comes closer, I want to bring to your attention our greatest expense called **key money**. When you sign a lease on an apartment in South Korea, a deposit needs to be made that affects the cost of the monthly rent. The amount of the key money that we are trying to raise is \$70,000. This amount should allow us to get a decent 3-bedroom apartment even in the pricy city of Seoul. We have already been putting aside our monthly support to an account designated for the key money and currently have a third of the needed amount. We expect that our frugality should account for two-thirds of our entire moving fund, but will not cover the entire cost. (For pastors needing more info, I'd be happy to answer any questions you may have.)

We have now been on deputation for one year and our support has climbed to 55%! We are now actively preparing to move to South Korea. There is a lot of planning that needs to be done before our schedule gets busy again. Please pray as you already have been that God will give wisdom and provision as we do His work.
