MARCH & APRIL 2024 Update

March Highlights:

1. BLIND FAITH MINISTRIES INSTITUTE:

☆ 25 men and 5 ladies attended the entire 2 week institute

Points were awarded on how many visitors were in each service, how many folks went soul winning, and how many Gospel tracts were given out. There was a wonderful spirit as we all pushed to find someone to bring!

April Highlights:

4. VISITORS: Bro. Neal Greenfield & Missionary Nick Maulucci came to visit us and the ministry. We had not personally met before their trip here, and we didn't know what to expect. Well, the Lord knit our hearts, gave us a great time of encouragement, and allowed us to minister together in the school Bible distribution project. We laughed & prayed & worked together. A refreshing visit.

5. BIBLE DISTRIBUTION PROJECT: Since we had extra help, we jumped on the opportunity to do a special project: Preaching and distributing Bibles to secondary level students (high school+ age). With letters of approval from all levels of local government, we were able to preach at 6 schools to over 3,000 students and give each of those students and teachers a Bible. Our team of soul winners talked to 315 students who made salvation decisions publicly. Then, on Sunday, over 50 students came to an afternoon activity, that lead into the evening service. 17 of those students made salvation decisions at church. **To God be the glory.** *Please pray for these students to keep the desire to learn and grow in Christ!*

6. RESULTS FROM GROWTH PROGRAM:

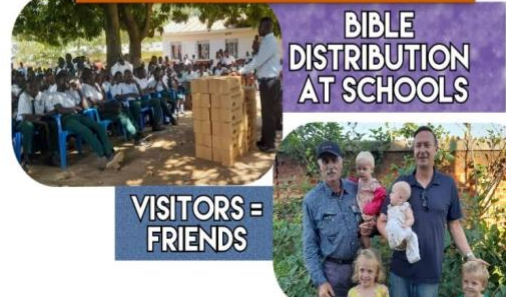
- Salvations 413 (332 from School project, 81 from church/soul winning)
